I wanted to give an update regarding the plans of WeCare Disaster Response as it relates to Haiti.

This past Wednesday, I flew to the Dominican Republic to facilitate logistical plans for the March trip to Haiti. As you can imagine, the needs of the Haiti people are great, and much needs to be done. Our logistical work is progressing nicely, and we look forward to working with ADRA International and Loma Linda University Global Outreach on our designated projects.

As you may be aware, the US State Department issued, on February 9, a travel advisory to Haiti for US citizens. WeCare Disaster Response is aware of the situation and continues to monitor the situation, both from the US State Department and from ADRA directors on the ground. We must, however, keep in mind that safety of our volunteers must be our top priority.

At this point in time, WeCare Disaster Response has not changed its focus with regard to the Haiti trip. I want to assure you that WeCare Disaster Response is focused on helping the people of Haiti, and will make every effort possible to make this a reality.
